

## BMX Bike Trail Rules

The BMX Bike Trail is available to the entire family. The City of Miamisburg has established the following rules for your safe and enjoyable use of this facility:

1. Warning: BMX bike riding can be a hazardous recreational activity. Use of this facility may result in death, paralysis, brain damage, concussion, broken bones or other serious injury. Please operate your bike wisely.
2. Any use of this facility is at your own risk. The City of Miamisburg does not assume any responsibility for injuries.
3. The BMX Bike Trail is designed for non-motorized bicycles only.
4. All ages are welcome to use the BMX trail.
5. The BMX trail opens at dawn and closes at dark.
6. General use of the BMX Trail is free.
7. The BMX Trail is a self-policing facility without City-provided supervision. Please be respectful of other bikers and follow the rules when utilizing this facility.
8. For your protection, safety equipment such as helmet, elbow pads, knee pads, wrist and shin guards and chest protectors are strongly recommended.
9. The following are not permitted in the BMX Trail area:
  - ❖ Alcoholic beverages
  - ❖ Smoking and/or tobacco products
  - ❖ Fighting
  - ❖ Profanity
  - ❖ Graffiti
  - ❖ Glass containers
  - ❖ Motorized vehicles
10. Unauthorized obstacles, ramps, other equipment or materials may not be added to the facility without City staff approval.
11. Certain weather conditions may create unsafe surfaces for trail use.
12. Bike only with the flow of traffic.
13. Spectators are required to remain outside of the trail areas.
14. All organized events require prior written approval from the Parks and Recreation Department.
15. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to close the trails for any circumstances.
16. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to restrict entry to the facility and ask persons to leave the facility if any of the rules are not followed or unsafe behavior is observed.
