

Skate Park Rules

(Approved by Miami Valley Risk Management Association)

The Miamisburg Skate Park facility is available to the entire family. The City of Miamisburg has established the following rules for your safe and enjoyable use of this facility:

1. Warning: skateboarding and skating can be hazardous recreational activities. Use of this facility may result in death, paralysis, brain damage, concussion, broken bones or other serious injury. Please skate wisely.
2. Any use of this facility is at your own risk. The City of Miamisburg does not assume any responsibility for injuries.
3. There are two areas to utilize: advanced and beginners. Please know your skill level and use the appropriate area.
4. The Skate Park is designed for skateboard and in-line skate use only. Riding, operating, or utilizing any device other than skateboards or in-line skates is not permitted.
5. All ages are welcome to use the Skate Park.
6. The Skate Park opens at dawn and closes at dark.
7. General use of this facility is free.
8. The Skate Park is a self-policing facility without City-provided supervision. Please be respectful of other skaters and follow the rules when utilizing this facility.
9. For your protection, safety equipment such as helmet, elbow pads, knee pads, wrist pads and ankle pads are strongly recommended.
10. The following are not permitted in the Skate Park Area:
 - ❖ Alcoholic beverages
 - ❖ Smoking and/or tobacco products
 - ❖ Fighting
 - ❖ Profanity
 - ❖ Graffiti
 - ❖ Tagging
 - ❖ Glass containers
 - ❖ Bicycles
 - ❖ Motorized vehicles
 - ❖ Scooters
 - ❖ Food and beverages
11. Keep pets on leash and away from the skating area.

12. Unauthorized obstacles, ramps, other equipment or materials may not be added to the facility without City staff approval.
13. Certain weather conditions may create unsafe surfaces for skating.
14. Skate only with the flow of traffic.
15. Spectators are required to remain outside of the skating area.
16. All organized events require prior written approval from the Parks and Recreation Department.
17. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to close the facility for any circumstances deemed necessary.
18. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to restrict entry to the facility and ask persons to leave the facility if any of the rules are not followed or unsafe behavior is observed.
