The City of Miamisburg is seeking sealed bids for the Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center Slide Re-Surfacing project at the Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center, 400 South Heincke Road, Miamisburg, Ohio 45342. Bids will be accepted in the Office of the City Manager, 10 North First Street, Miamisburg, Ohio 45342 until 9:00 AM EST Tuesday, February 21, 2012, at which time and place proposals will be opened and read aloud publicly.

Bid documents, specifications, the proposal and contract forms are available, free of charge at the Parks and Recreation Office, 10 North First Street, Miamisburg, Ohio 45342, online at [www.ci.miamisburg.oh.us](http://www.ci.miamisburg.oh.us) or by calling 937-866-4532.

Bidders must endorse their name, and the project bid for, upon the outside of the envelopes containing their bids and shall use the forms provided by the Parks and Recreation Department, as none other will be accepted. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity on bid packet reference sheet. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than April 27, 2012.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code equivalent to one hundred percent (100%) of the bid price for the project. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on public improvements in Montgomery County, Ohio, as determined by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.

The City of Miamisburg, Ohio reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities, and further, reserves the right to accept any bids or parts of bids which it deems to best serve the interest of the City of Miamisburg, Ohio. No bids may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after bid opening. ## **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

The purpose of this project is to re-surface the two existing flume slides location at the Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center, 400 South Heincke Road, Miamisburg, Ohio 45342. This project includes re-surfacing the interior and exterior surfaces of the existing raft slide and existing body slide to the color of the owner's choosing returning the slide surfaces to a like-new condition. The Base Bid includes preparing, priming, coating and finish coating the interior and exterior of both slides as well as removing damaged caulking along slide joints and re-caulking joints to a like-new condition. The Alternate Bid includes preparing, priming, coating and finish coating the interior and exterior of both slides as well as permanently sealing the approximately 46 slide joints with a 2-component polyurethane joint sealer.

1. Caution: The Contractor is cautioned to thoroughly familiarize himself with the Plans, Specifications, Special Notes, General Information, Appendices and other pertinent data as set forth. Also, to note carefully any regulations governing hours of work, minimum wages to be paid, insurance requirements, etc., all of which form a part of this proposal and/or contract the same as if they were printed herein.
2. Bidders are advised to examine, before submitting their bids, the ground where the work is to be done and all the surrounding conditions and circumstances affecting the work as well as the drawings, specifications and form of contract. The submission of a proposal will be construed as an acknowledgment that the bidder fully understands the conditions and difficulties of the work, and the plans, specifications, form of contract and all matters relating to the project. All bidders are encouraged, though not required to attend the pre-bid meeting described on page 3 of the bid document.
3. Each bid or proposal must be made on the enclosed printed form, and the proposal together with a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond, as hereinafter provided for, enclosed in a sealed envelope directed to the City Manager, Civic Center, 10 North First Street, Miamisburg, Ohio, and endorsed on the outside of the envelope:

Plans and Profiles, specifications and blank proposals may be obtained at the Parks and Recreation office, 10 North First Street, Miamisburg, Ohio 45342.

4. Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond, in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond Form shall be equivalent to 100% of the bid price for the project, including alternatives, and shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.
5. Each bid shall contain the full name and correct address of every person, firm or company interested in same. In case the bidder is a corporation, the title of the officer signing the Proposal must be stated and if requested, evidence of authority of such officer to bind the corporation must be given. In case of a partnership, the signature of at least one of the partners must follow the firm name, using the term "member of firm." In case of an individual, use the term "Doing business as \_\_\_\_\_", or "sole owner."
6. Bids shall state the price for each item enumerated in the schedule for the kind of improvement bid upon, except in contracts involving alternate bid items in which the Contractor has the option of bidding on one or more of said alternates. The price for each item carried forward. In case of errors or discrepancies, the individual prices as shown will govern in the computation of the bid. Failure to comply with the provisions of this section may be deemed sufficient ground for rejection of any bid.
7. The lowest and best bidder will be selected from the contractors submitting a bid proposal. Other factors such as previous experience with the City of Miamisburg or other entities, ability to complete the project in a timely manner and ability to perform the work may also be considered. Other appropriate factors may also be considered.
8. No modification of a proposal will be permitted after it has been submitted.
9. Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud.
10. The City of Miamisburg, Ohio reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities, and further, reserves the right to accept any bids or parts of bids which it deems to best serve the interest of the City of Miamisburg, Ohio.
11. Evidence of collusion among bidders shall be sufficient cause for rejection of any or all bids. Participants in such collusion will receive no recognition as bidders for any future work of the City.
12. Prior to the award of the contract, the City Manager may require the bidder to file a statement of the extent of his experience in the line of work herein proposed to be done, and the amount of capital and equipment he has available for the work.

13. The amount of the uncompleted work that the bidder has on hand, which might hinder or prevent the prompt completion of additional work if awarded, will be considered by the City Manager in determining the lowest and best bid. The Owner shall have the right to take such steps as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to perform his obligations under the contract, and the Bidder shall furnish the Owner all such information and data for this purpose as it may request. The right is reserved to reject any bid where an investigation of the available evidence or information does not satisfy the Owner that the Bidder is qualified to carry out properly the terms of the contract.

Failure to have performed satisfactorily for any contract previously awarded to the Bidder by the City may be sufficient cause for rejection of its proposal.

14. The successful bidder will be required to submit four (4) executed counterparts of the Contract and Bond.
15. If, at any time after execution and approval of this Contract and the performance bond required by the Contract Documents, the City of Miamisburg shall deem any of the sureties upon such bond to be unsatisfactory or if, for any reason, such bond shall cease to be adequate security for the City of Miamisburg, the Contractor shall within five days after notice by the City of Miamisburg to do so, furnish a new or additional bond, in form, sum and signed by such sureties as shall be satisfactory to the City of Miamisburg. No further payment shall be deemed due nor made to the Contractor unless and until such new or additional bond shall be furnished and approved.
16. The successful bidder upon any improvement should not begin work under any circumstances before entrance into the written contract with the City and furnishing surety bond in accordance with the laws of Ohio and sections of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Miamisburg applicable to executing and entering into such contracts.
17. Each laborer, workman or mechanic employed by the Contractor, the Subcontractor or any person about or upon the work to be performed in this project will be paid not less than the prevailing wages as required by the Statutes of the State of Ohio. (Sections 4115.01 R.C. to 4115.14 R.C.) The schedule attached to the proposal is the last schedule furnished the City by the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of Ohio, but may not be the final controlling schedule of minimum wages and should be used as a guide only. The final controlling minimum wages are those paid in the same trade or occupation in the locality where such public work is being performed, under collective agreements or understanding between bona fide organizations of labor and employers at the time the contract is made and approved by the City Council. If there is no understanding in the immediate locality, then the prevailing rates of wages in the nearest locality shall control.

The contractor shall make his payroll record in connection with the performance of this contract available for inspection by the City at its request for the purpose of determining that the wages paid by the Contractor to all persons employed in the performance of said contract are not less than those required by the laws of the State of Ohio. (Section 4115.01 to 4115.14 R.C.) Upon completion of the contract and prior to the final payment, the Contractor shall furnish an affidavit to the City stating that the wages paid to all persons employed by the Contractor in the performance of said contract have not been less than those required by the Laws of the State of Ohio (Section 4115.01 to 4115.14 R.C.) on the date the contract is made and approved by the City Council.

In regards to Labor:

- a. All Contractors employed upon the work shall and will be required to conform to all Labor Laws of the State of Ohio and to all other laws, ordinances and legal requirements applicable thereto.
  - b. All labor shall be performed in the best and most workmanlike manner by those skilled in their respective trades. The standards of the work required throughout shall be of such grade as will bring results of the first class only.
18. The successful bidder will be required to provide the City with copies of insurance certificates which indicate that the bidder is carrying the following types of insurance: worker's compensation, comprehensive general liability, and automobile liability. The City at no time will be responsible for damage or injury occurring to bidders personnel or equipment. THE CITY SHALL BE NAMED AS AN ADDITIONAL INSURED PARTY ON THE POLICY.

Insurance coverage shall be at least as broad as Insurance Services Office form number GL0002 (Ed. 1/73) covering Comprehensive General Liability and Insurance Services Office form number GL0404 covering Broad Form Comprehensive General Liability; or Insurance Services Office Commercial General Liability coverage ("occurrence" form CG0001). The bidder shall maintain limits on both comprehensive general liability and automobile liability insurance of no less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage.

This insurance during the life of this agreement will not be suspended, voided, canceled, or reduced in coverage or in limits except after thirty (30) days prior written Notice has been given to the City. The City reserves the right to cancel the agreement if the vendor fails to maintain the required insurance coverage.

The bidder shall include all subcontractors as insureds under its policies or shall furnish separate certificates and endorsements for each subcontractor. All coverage for subcontractors shall be subject to all the requirements stated herein.



19. No Contract between the City and the Bidder shall be deemed to exist until a fully executed copy thereof has been tendered and/or delivered to the Contractor or his duly authorized agent or representative.
20. The Contractor to whom the Contract is awarded shall comply fully with the provisions of Sec. 153.59 and 153.60, Revised Code of Ohio relative to discrimination and intimidation of employees.
21. The Contractor shall procure at his own expense all necessary permits from the municipal or other public authorities, shall give all notices required by law or ordinances, and shall pay all fees and charges incident to the due and lawful prosecution of the work covered by this Contract, and shall comply with all laws, regulations and ordinances.
22. Payments to the Contractor shall be made in accordance with applicable sections of the City of Miamisburg, Ordinance No. 4403.

#### CITY OF MIAMISBURG RETAINAGE REGULATIONS

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 4403, adopted February 5, 1991, for any project where it is determined to be in the City's best interest to retain funds, the following procedures will apply in lieu of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 153.

1. The City of Miamisburg will pay the contractor at the rate of 90% of submitted and approved invoices (retaining 10%) during the project.
  2. Upon successful completion of the project and full acceptance by the City, within 30 days retained funds will be paid to the contractor.
23. The project shall be completed by the contractor and accepted by the City on or before the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2012.

In addition to any damages or claims available to the City due to any and all acts of malfeasance, misfeasance, nonfeasance, negligence, undue delay or failure to adequately perform the work under the within contract/agreement, contractor shall be liable to the City of Miamisburg in the amount of \$100.00 per day for each day the work is not complete within the terms of the contract/agreement, when no written extension of time has been granted by the City. Extensions of time may be granted to the contractor for delays beyond the Contactor's control, such as severe or unusual climatic conditions, acts of God, or industrial conditions not foreseeable before the bid date.

24. The Contractor shall guarantee all the work for a period of one (1) year from the date set forth in the "Total Bid", against defects resulting from the use of inferior materials, equipment or workmanship. This guarantee period shall be covered by the "Contract Bond" as agreed upon between the Owner and the Contractor prior to the final payment for the work.

The Contractor will be required during the life of this guarantee to make all repairs or changes in the guaranteed work, which in the opinion of the Owner are necessary as the result of the use of materials, equipment, or workmanship which are inferior, defective or not in accordance with the terms of the Contract Documents.

The Contractor shall, promptly upon receipt of notice from the Owner and without expense to the Owner, remove and replace all unsatisfactory work with suitable materials and equipment.

25. The Owner will pay to the Contractor the total earned compensation as stated in the Total Bid, less all prior payments and advances whatsoever, to or for the account of the Contractor and all amounts to be kept and retained under the provisions of these Contract Documents. All prior payments, including those relating to "Changes in Work" or "Extra Work" shall be subject to correction by this Total Bid for payment of the work included under these Contract Documents. The one (1) year guarantee period shall commence on the date of the final acceptance of the project.

26. All bidders shall comply with Ohio Revised Code Section 5719.042 which requires all bidders to submit a verified statement of whether or not said bidders are delinquent with respect to the personal property taxes enumerated in said Section 5719.042.

Such statement shall be incorporated in the final agreement and contract as an exhibit thereto.

27. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days.

28. The contractor shall prepare a construction schedule prior to the start of actual construction which must be approved by Ryan Davis, Parks and Facilities Superintendent for the City of Miamisburg.

29. The contractor's attention is directed to the fact that the City of Miamisburg has an Income Tax Ordinance, (937) 847-6462.

30. Changes in the Scope of work or contract documents will be issued in the form of a written addendum to all bidders of record no less than 48 hours before the bid opening. Any issued addenda will be considered as a part of the contract documents and a signed receipt must be included with the bid packet when it is presented.

31. Inspection: All work will be subject to inspection at any time and approved by the Owner and/or designee.

32. Proposals will be considered irregular and may be rejected for the following reasons:
- a. If the proposal is on a form other than that furnished by the Owner or if the form is altered or any part thereof is detached.
  - b. If there are unauthorized additions, conditional or alternate bids, qualifying statements, or irregularities of any kind which may tend to make the proposal incomplete, indefinite, or ambiguous as to its meaning.
  - c. If the Bidder adds any provisions reserving the right to accept or reject an award or to enter into a contract pursuant to an award. This does not exclude a bid limiting the maximum gross amount of awards acceptable to any one Bidder at any one bid letting, provided that the Owner will make any selection of awards.

## **Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center Slide Re-Surfacing**

### DESCRIPTION OF WORK

#### **Section I – GENERAL**

This project includes the resurfacing and restoration of the existing two (2) flume slides located at Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center. One slide is a raft slide and the other is a body slide. The general scope of work includes the preparation, priming, color coating and finish coating the interior and exterior of both flume slides (approximately 7540 square feet of surface to be coated). As an Alternate Bid price, bidders may include the price to permanently seal existing joints between flume slide sections (Section III). If the alternate bid is not selected by the City of Miamisburg, project scope will include the removal of damaged and worn joint caulking and re-installation of new joint caulking (Section II). All work in this bid shall be completed by the contractor(s). The scope of work will include all supplies, tools, lifts, and scaffoldings provided by the contractor(s) to complete the work outlined in the scope. The demolition/removal of existing materials and their disposal will also be completed by the contractor(s) awarded the bid. All items outlined in the scope of work must be completed no later than Friday, April 27, 2012.

#### 1. Alternate Bid:

Bidders may provide along with their primary bid proposal, an alternate bid which includes all items in the scope or work (section III) including the permanent sealing of joints located between flume slide sections.

#### 2. Materials:

Bidders are permitted to use products other than those listed in the scope of work (Section II and III) below, however products must be of equivalent quality. Bidder must provide the City of Miamisburg with the coating product information on the product to be applied at the time of bid submission.

### 3. Contractor & Subcontractor Relationship

The Bidder may act as a General Contractor and appoint a certified applicator as the subcontractor to perform all the work outlined in the scope of work below. The General Contractor will notify the City of Miamisburg with the contact information of the subcontractor.

### 4. Manufacturer's Directions:

All manufactured articles, material and equipment shall be applied, installed, connected, erected, used, cleaned and conditioned as directed by manufacturers.

### 5. Protection:

- a. The Contractor shall protect existing building, all trees, shrubs, lawns, and all landscape work from damage, providing guards and covering. Any damaged work shall be repaired or replaced at the Contractor's expense.
- b. Weather Protection: The Contractor shall at all times provide protection against weather (rain, wind, storms, frost or heat) so as to maintain all work, materials, apparatus and fixtures free from injury or damage. At the end of the day's work, all new work likely to be damaged shall be covered.
- c. The Contractor shall provide and maintain barricades at all railings and obstructions in the streets, roads, or sidewalks adjacent to public walks or roads.
- d. Damage: Any work damaged by failure to provide protection above required shall be removed and replaced with new work at the Contractor's expense.
- e. Utility Obstructions: The Contractor shall promptly notify the City Engineer should excavation or construction work encounter any utility service lines of any type (water, sewer, electric, gas, telephone, etc.) not shown or provided for on the plans. Such lines if in the way of the work will be moved, relocated or disconnected by the utility company involved. The Contractor shall take every precaution to save such lines from damage or disruption of service and shall replace such lines if damaged.

### 6. Remove all excess material from the site.



## Section II – SCOPE OF WORK (BASE BID)

Re-surface, protect and rejuvenate the interior and exterior surfaces of both water slides at Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center with a Clear Shield and/or Color coatings and re-caulk slide joints.

- (1) Remove all worn or degraded caulk from the interior slide joints.
- (2) Remove all surface contaminants by using a non-acidic scale removal chemical, such as Calcitrol™, on all surfaces to be coated including interior riding path and exterior fiberglass skin.
- (3) Pressure wash the interior and exterior surfaces to be coated with a non-petroleum distillate degreaser, such as Slide Detergent™ and rinse with de-ionized clean water.
- (4) Inspect slide surface and repair any damage to sections. If necessary this may include adding layers of fiberglass to strengthen slide structure. Areas should be strengthened to ensure end product is in like-new condition.
- (5) Sand the surfaces to be coated to create an adequate adhesion profile for the water slide restoration coating system; primer, topcoat and sealer.
- (6) Remove all powder and dust created from sanding with a high pressure air hose, commercial vacuum cleaner, or pressure washer.
- (7) Wipe the surfaces to be coated with an adhesion prep solvent based chemical solution, such as SlidePrep™, using a white cotton cloth.
- (8) Apply to all surfaces to be coated (interior and exterior of both slides):
  - (i) Water slide fiberglass adhesion base coat primer, such as Adhesion Base Coat – ABC Primer™. Allow surfaces to cure. Dry film thickness must be a minimum of 3-5 mils.
  - (ii) Water slide solid color of owner's choosing, high gloss, UV stable, non-chalking, hydrophobic, Polyurethane/Polyurea coating such as Slide Renu® Color Shield™. Allow surfaces to cure. Interior surfaces dry film thickness must be a minimum of 7-9 mils for raft slides, 5-7 mils for body slides. Exterior surfaces dry film thickness must be a minimum of 3-5 mils.
- (9) After the water slide coating has reached a functional cure, lightly wet sand the interior surfaces to remove any undesirable surface imperfections or unwanted profiles that may have been deposited by airborne contaminants during the curing process.
- (10) Apply a clear bonding primer in the slide joint to improve adhesion with the joint compound and reseal the joints using waterproof, non-shrink caulking with suitable adhesion to fiberglass, such as SikaFlex™. Silicone sealants will not be permitted.
- (11) Wipe the interior surface with a solvent based cleaner, such as SlidePrep™, using a white cotton cloth.
- (12) Apply a clear chlorine and UV resistant protective sealer, such as ChloroShield™.
- (13) Polish the slide with a water slide medium grit compound, such as SlidePolish™.
- (14) Wax the slide with a polymer wax, such as SlideWax™.

The above bid specs have been developed by SlideRenu® and its certified waterslide technicians to ensure water park operators accurately specify the process required to properly resurface sun damaged water slide surfaces and to restore slide joints back to their like-new conditions.

### Section III – SCOPE OF WORK (ALTERNATE BID)

Re-surface, protect and rejuvenate the interior and exterior surfaces of both water slides at Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center with a Clear Shield and/or Color coatings and permanently seal slide joints.

- (1) Remove all worn or degraded caulk from the interior slide joints.
- (2) Remove all surface contaminants by using a non-acidic scale removal chemical, such as Calcitrol™, on all surfaces to be coated including interior riding path and exterior fiberglass skin.
- (3) Pressure wash the interior and exterior surfaces to be coated with a non-petroleum distillate degreaser, such as Slide Detergent™ and rinse with de-ionized clean water.
- (4) Inspect slide surface and repair any damage to sections. If necessary this may include adding layers of fiberglass to strengthen slide structure. Areas should be strengthened to ensure end product is in like-new condition.
- (5) Sand the surfaces to be coated to create an adequate adhesion profile for the water slide restoration coating system; primer, topcoat and sealer.
- (6) Remove all powder and dust created from sanding with a high pressure air hose, commercial vacuum cleaner, or pressure washer.
- (7) Permanently seal the approximately 46 interior joints with a 2 component polyurethane sealer, such as Perma-Joint Sealer™, to create a smooth, flat and safe transition between the fiberglass sections.
- (8) Wipe the surfaces to be coated with an adhesion prep solvent based chemical solution, such as SlidePrep™, using a white cotton cloth.
- (9) Apply to all surfaces to be coated (interior and exterior of both slides):
  - (i) Water slide fiberglass adhesion base coat primer, such as Adhesion Base Coat – ABC Primer™. Allow surfaces to cure. Dry film thickness must be a minimum of 3-5 mils.
  - (ii) Water slide solid color, high gloss, UV stable, non-chalking, hydrophobic, Polyurethane/Polyurea coating such as Slide Renu® Color Shield™. Allow surfaces to cure. Interior surfaces dry film thickness must be a minimum of 7-9 mils for raft slides, 5-7 mils for body slides. Exterior surfaces dry film thickness must be a minimum of 3-5 mils.
- (10) After the water slide coating has reached a functional cure, lightly wet sand the interior surfaces to remove any undesirable surface imperfections or unwanted profiles that may have been deposited by airborne contaminants during the curing process.
- (11) Wipe the interior surface with a solvent based cleaner, such as SlidePrep™, using a white cotton cloth.
- (12) Apply a clear chlorine and UV resistant protective sealer, such as ChloraShield™.
- (13) Polish the slide with a water slide medium grit compound, such as SlidePolish™.
- (14) Wax the slide with a polymer wax, such as SlideWax™.

The above bid specs have been developed by SlideRenu® and its certified waterslide technicians to ensure water park operators accurately specify the process required to properly resurface sun damaged water slide surfaces and to restore slide joints back to their like-new conditions.

#### **Section IV – Surface Preparation**

All slide surfaces to be re-coated will be sanded and cleaned with a product such as SlidePrep™ cleaning products and/or other commercial surface preparation products which either meet or exceed current environmental regulations, i.e. biodegradable, human safety, non-hazardous material disposal, etc. The surface preparation products will be applied by the contractor(s)/subcontractor(s) in accordance with the surface preparations application instructions provided by the manufacturer of the coatings. Product data sheets for the surface preparation materials will be furnished upon request. Bidder is required to repair any damaged sections of fiberglass prior to applying surface primer or surface coatings.

#### **Section V – Surface Coatings**

All slide surfaces to be re-coated will be coated with a product such as SlideRenu™ Color and/or Clear Shield at the recommended coverage rates established by the coating's manufacturer;

- (1) 7-9 mils Dry Film Thickness on any interior raft slide riding path (as defined by the existing water flow line)
- (2) 5-7 mils Dry Film Thickness on any interior body slide riding path (as defined by the existing water flow line)
- (3) 3-5 mils Dry Film Thickness on an interior side walls and the exterior fiberglass skin

The coating will be applied by the contractor(s)/subcontractor(s) in accordance with the application instructions with a product such as Sun Shield Coatings to ensure the long term performance of the coating. The product SlideRenu® is a division of Sun Shield Coatings. A representative of the manufacturer of a product such as SlideRenu® may be on-site at various times during the re-surfacing process to oversee the coating application. MSDS data sheets for all products will be furnished.

#### **Section VI – Surface Coating Color**

Color choice of surface coatings will be made by the owner. Awarded bidder will provide owner options for color choices and timelines necessary to choose color in order to meet specified deadlines of project. It is the responsibility of the contractor(s)/subcontractor(s) to ensure color match is accurate to owners' specifications.

#### **Section VII – Warranty**

The product manufacturer of the chosen coating system will provide a written warranty on the coatings against excessive color-fading, excessive gloss degradation, on the re-surfaced slide in accordance with the Limited Product Warranty. With the exception of the riding path, all vertical restored surfaces should be guaranteed against peeling, cracking or racking or blistering for up to 10 years. The Limited Product Warranty will be provided at the time of the bid so it can be reviewed for complete details, definitions and the conditions of warranty.

A warranty certificate will be issued at the completion of the project to the owner indicating the applicable warranty periods as outlined above with respect to gloss retention, chalking, fading, uniformity and adhesion.

#### **Section VIII – Preventative Maintenance**

If the product manufacturer recommends a program of preventative maintenance to ensure the long lasting effectiveness of the coating system, this preventative maintenance plan shall be submitted in writing to the owner at the completion of the project.

### **Section IX – Hours of Work and Working Conditions**

Hours of work shall not be before 7:00 AM or after 8:00 PM Monday through Friday without specific prior approval 24 hours in advance.

Holiday work is permitted only with prior approval. Holidays are defined as those allowed by the City of Miamisburg for its offices. Good Friday, April 6, 2012 should be the only Holidays affected.

The contractor shall protect the public from the construction debris, dust, traffic and any other obnoxious items related to the project. The contractor shall maintain a safe working environment which may include barricades and/or fencing to protect the public.

Any flammable or hazardous materials must be stored in properly marked and safety compliant containers. Tools and equipment storage on-site must be approved by the Parks and Facilities Superintendent.

The contractor shall notify the Parks and Facilities Superintendent immediately if any conditions are discovered that will not allow proper completion of the project as described in the specifications.

The contractor shall take appropriate means to protect the Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center, including all sidewalks, pool shell, light posts, awnings, exterior lights, curbs, roadways, utilities, conduits and landscaping.

#### **PARKING**

The Contractor, it's employees and any Subcontractors and their employees shall park their personal and work vehicles in areas as designated. These areas may be 100 feet or more away from the immediate work site.

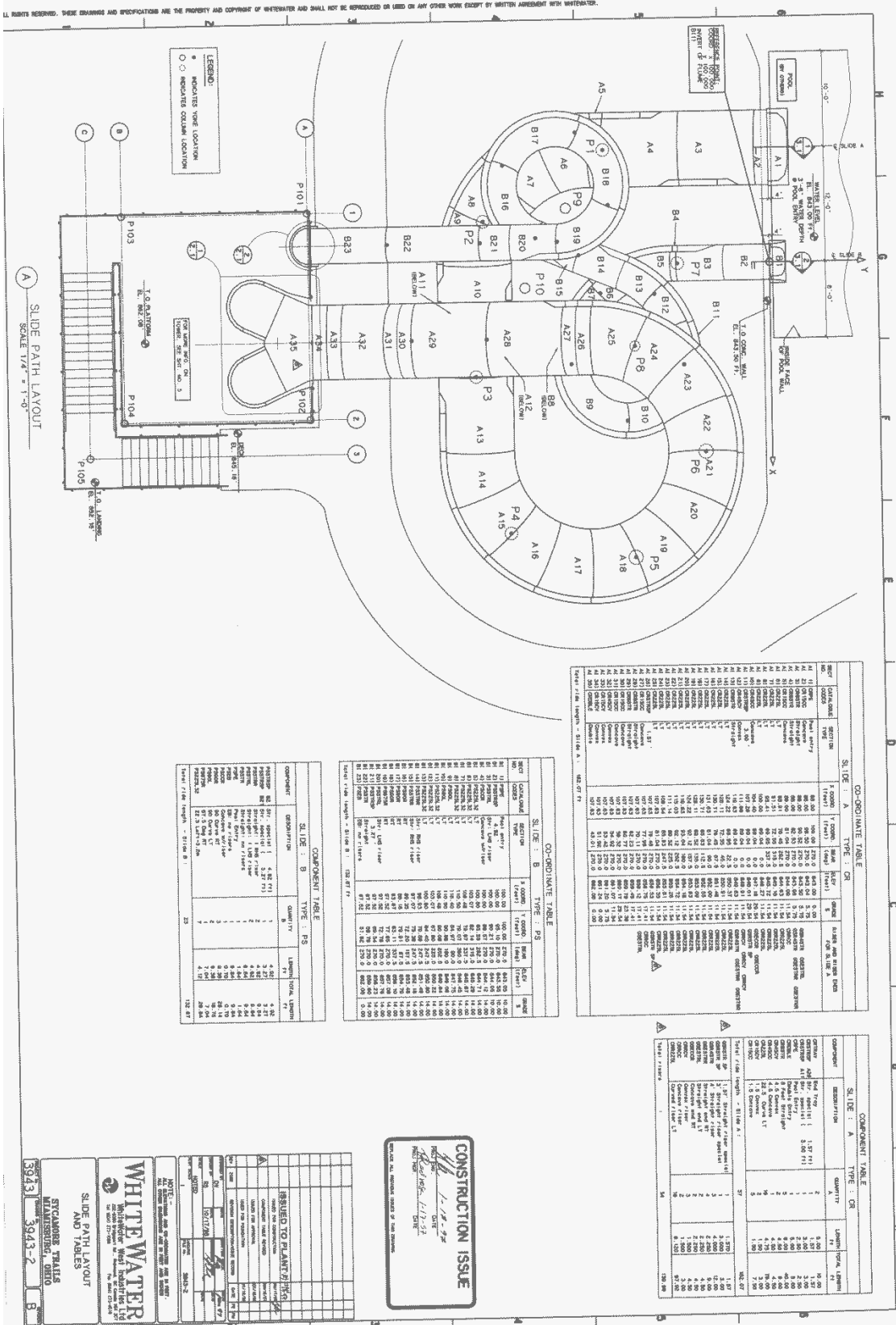
#### **RESTROOMS**

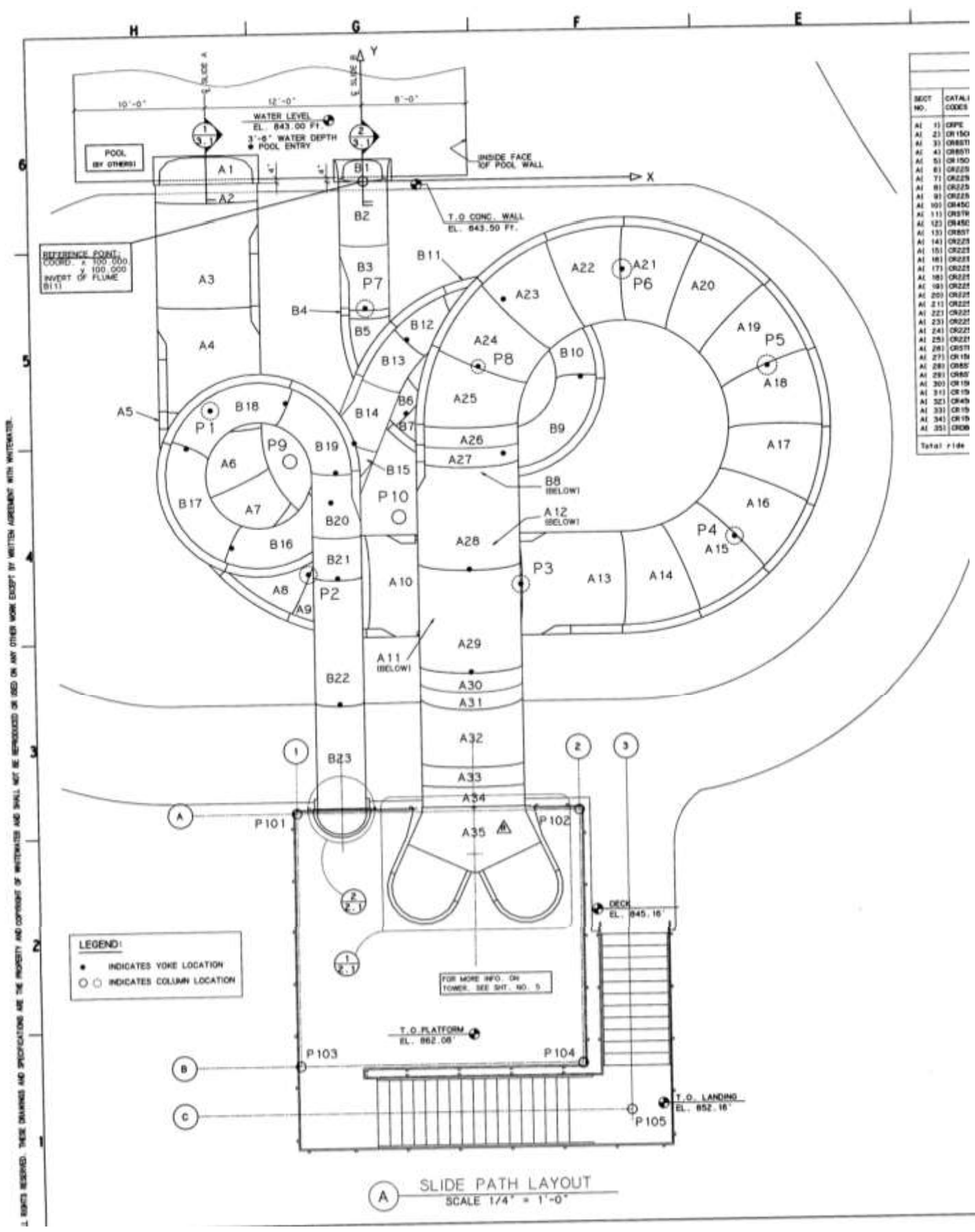

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The body of each wage determination lists the classification and wage rates that have been found to be prevailing for the cited type(s) of construction in the area covered by the wage determination. The classifications are listed in alphabetical order of "identifiers" that indicate whether the particular

rate is union or non-union.

### Union Identifiers

An identifier enclosed in dotted lines beginning with characters other than "SU" denotes that the union classification and rate have found to be prevailing for that classification. Example: PLUM0198-005 07/01/2011. The first four letters, PLUM, indicate the international union and the four-digit number, 0198, that follows indicates the local union number or district council number where applicable, i.e., Plumbers Local 0198. The next number, 005 in the example, is an internal number used in processing the wage determination. The date, 07/01/2011, following these characters is the effective date of the most current negotiated rate/collective bargaining agreement which would be July 1, 2011 in the above example.

Union prevailing wage rates will be updated to reflect any changes in the collective bargaining agreements governing the rate.

### Non-Union Identifiers

Classifications listed under an "SU" identifier were derived from survey data by computing average rates and are not union rates; however, the data used in computing these rates may include both union and non-union data. Example: SULA2004-007 5/13/2010. SU indicates the rates are not union rates, LA indicates the State of Louisiana; 2004 is the year of the survey; and 007 is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. A 1993 or later date, 5/13/2010, indicates the classifications and rates under that identifier were issued as a General Wage Determination on that date.

Survey wage rates will remain in effect and will not change until a new survey is conducted.

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## WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- \* an existing published wage determination
- \* a survey underlying a wage determination
- \* a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- \* a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour Regional Office for the area in which the survey was conducted because those Regional Offices have responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:

2.) If the answer to the question in 1.) is yes, then an interested party (those affected by the action) can request review and reconsideration from the Wage and Hour Administrator (See 29 CFR Part 1.8 and 29 CFR Part 7). Write to:

The request should be accompanied by a full statement of the interested party's position and by any information (wage payment data, project description, area practice material, etc.) that the requestor considers relevant to the issue.

3.) If the decision of the Administrator is not favorable, an interested party may appeal directly to the Administrative Review Board (formerly the Wage Appeals Board). Write to:
