

SWIM ATTIRE POLICY

Proper swim attire must be worn at Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center. Proper swim attire is defined as attire that is designed for aquatic use. Appropriate swim attire may not be altered, manipulated, or modified in a way that exposes excessive skin as determined by the Management Staff.

PERMITTED SWIM ATTIRE

- Swim suit *with lining* (one or two piece suit is permitted for females)
- Board shorts
- Jammers or racing suit (i.e. Speedo, Adidas, TYR)
- T-shirt worn over acceptable swim suit for sunburn protection

YOUNG CHILDREN IN DIAPERS

- Young children in diapers must wear rubber pants or swim diapers while in the pool. Swim diapers are available at Guest Services for \$2.00.



NOT PERMITTED ATTIRE

- Any short/pant *without lining* (i.e. Gym or Athletic, Jean, Khakis, Sweat suit, or Boxer)
- Thong bottoms
- Bras/Lingerie in place of an acceptable swim suit top
- Underwear (including boxers) in place of an acceptable swim suit bottom
- Any swimwear that exposes excessive skin as determined by Management

Failure to adhere to the Swim Attire Policy will result in dismissal from the Aquatic Center without refund or voucher.

RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Violation of general rules or any conduct that may endanger or impair the safety of anyone may be cause for permanent expulsion from the Aquatic Center, without refund of fees.
2. For your safety, obey aquatic staff at all times.
3. Do not distract the lifeguards from their duties.
4. The Aquatic Center may close for the following reasons:
 - In the event of inclement weather, i.e. lightning, thunder, rain;
 - If the temperature drops below 65 degrees;
 - If there are twenty (20) people or less in the facility;
 - In order to maintain the health and safety of our guests, the Manager may close the pool and/or facility without advanced notice.
5. The following are not permitted within the facility:
 - Articles made wholly or partly of glass;
 - Chewing gum;
 - Selling, consuming, or possessing intoxicating beverages or drugs;
 - Coolers larger than 20" x 20";
 - Running, pushing, horseplay, profanity, spitting, etc.;
 - Throwing items that may cause injury;
 - Smoking and tobacco products;
 - Public displays of affection;
 - Use of rollerblades, skates, skateboards, and bicycles beyond the admissions booth;
 - Rafts or other floatation devices larger than 14" in diameter.
6. Diving is permitted in designated areas only.
7. Smoking is permitted in designated areas outside of the Aquatic Center by persons eighteen (18) years of age or older.
8. Personal music devices must be kept at a reasonable volume.
9. Showers are required when leaving the sand volleyball courts and sand play area.
10. Floatation devices permitted in pool: personal water wings, water rings 14" in diameter or smaller, or fun noodles. Adult supervision is recommended. (Use of these items is restricted to areas of the pool shallower than 5' in depth).
11. Lounge chairs are available to customers, 18 years of age and older. Personal lounge chairs may be brought into the facility.
12. Rest breaks are scheduled on the hour for fifteen (15) minutes. Children seventeen (17) and under must exit the pool. Children three (3) and under may remain in the water if accompanied by an adult.
13. Facility evening hours include programming that requires certain areas of the pool to close for a predetermined amount of time.
14. Any person caught stealing personal or city property will be permanently expelled from the Aquatic Center. In addition, the City of Miamisburg may pursue legal action to the fullest degree possible.
15. Any person causing malicious damage to the Aquatic Center or grounds will be held financially responsible for damages. Additionally, the Manager reserves the right to suspend swimming and/or admission privileges for a period of time.
16. A pay phone is located in the entrance area for emergencies and general use. Anyone caught using this phone inappropriately may have their swimming and/or admission privileges suspended for a period of time.
17. Aquatic Center rules will be amended when deemed advisable for the protection of health, safety, and the enjoyment of all patrons.
18. The Manager on duty has authority to enforce all the Aquatic Center Rules and Regulations at his or her discretion, with penalties up to and including expulsion or suspended admission privileges.

HEALTH AND SAFETY PRACTICES

In order to maintain the health and safety of our guests, the Manager may close the pool and/or facility without advanced notice for an undetermined amount of time.

REMEMBER TO PRACTICE HEALTHY SWIMMING!

- PLEASE take a shower before swimming and wash your hands after using the toilet or changing diapers. Germs on your body end up in the water.
- PLEASE do not swallow pool water and avoid getting water in your mouth.
- PLEASE do not swim when you have or have had diarrhea. This is especially important for kids in diapers.
- PLEASE take your children on bathroom breaks and check diapers often.
- PLEASE change diapers in a bathroom and not poolside. Young children should always wear swim diapers. If you do not have swim diapers they are available for purchase at Guest Services for \$2.00 each.



REMEMBER TO PRACTICE WATER SAFETY!

- PLEASE remember to keep an eye on your children at all times.
- PLEASE use life jackets or life preservers for children who cannot swim. Air-filled swimming aids (such as water-wings) for children are permitted at Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center, but these should not be used in place of life jackets or life preservers. Life jackets are free to use and are available at Guest Services.
- PLEASE protect yourself and your children against sunburn by using a sunscreen with at least SPF 15 and both UVA and UVB protection. Be sure to re-apply sunscreen after swimming.
