ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AVAILABILITY NOTICE

The Ohio EPA, through the Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) program, is considering funding a project in Miamisburg, Ohio, which is subject to environmental review requirements. The city's proposed project consists of making twelve improvements at or adjacent to its existing water treatment facility (WTF) and wellfield. Of them, the major new water treatment component will consist of a water softening building housing reverse osmosis and other water treatment units, and a new discharge of reverse osmosis concentrate water to the Great Miami River through about 1400 feet of outfall sewer. The other parts include storm water improvements, miscellaneous site improvements (such as paving and fencing), a maintenance building, a standby generator system, exterior painting of the existing clearwell, modifications to site piping, changes to structural, electrical, and HVAC facilities, electrical improvements to the well field, SCADA improvements, fiber optic installation, and construction of microwave communications improvements at multiple sites throughout the city.

As Ohio EPA will be issuing a Draft Finding of No Significant Impact and an accompanying Environmental Assessment (EA) on this project in the near future, this notice is to advise the public that it will have a 30-day period in which to review the EA and provide comments to the Ohio EPA contact named at the back of the document. This public comment period will begin with the release of the document to the public through Ohio EPA's web site and distribution of the document to interested parties.
